

Integrated Pest Management Plan (IPM) - Armadillo Technical Institute (2019)

As required by ORS 634.700 (<https://www.oregonlaws.org/ors/634.700>)

PREVENTION:

1. Frequent cleaning of all spaces
2. Food and other attractants sealed and appropriately stored
3. No feeding of feral animals on campus
4. Access to buildings sealed
 - a. Crawl spaces screened or boarded

RESPONSE:

Physical Reponse: Armadillo Technical Institute (ATI) may set physical traps to respond to small scale pest presence. Traps will be set in spaces or times that limit student exposure.

Chemical Resposne: ATI will contract with licensed and bonded professionals in the event that a pesticide is required beyond small scale management that may be accessed through retail purchase. These OTC products will be enclosed to prevent accidental exposure and stored securely to prevent student access to products. OTC pest management products being used on campus will appear on our school website at www.armadillotech.org

OTC pesticide may be used periodically including:

- Terro Liquid Ant Bait (enclosed)
- Tomcat Rat & Mouse Killer (enclosed)
